7. Categories and classes

Standard bikes (with valid certification book)

- Street 10,5
- Street Twin 12,0

Modified bikes (with valid sport bike certificate or with valid certification book)

- Modified Street Twin
- Super Street Bikes

Special motorcycles (with valid sport bike certificate)

- Junior dragster
- Teenager Dragster
- National dragster
- Competition dragster
- Super Twin Top Gas

There can be special class for „Arrival riders“ – Public bike“. In this class can start riders with series bikes and valid Bike registration documents and registration mark. Dragbike centrum is authorized to issue one event licence (400 CZK) and to arrange insurance policy. After riders are eligible to take a part in Public Bike Class. This class will be held in system „Canonball“. Riders will ride four heats, the worst time will be cancelled and time of remaining heats will be counted up. Winner is rider with the best time.

8. Entry forms

Date of sending is decisive.

Entry fee is 100% more for entry forms delivered after May 29th 2009!!

The riders starting in the class of standard motorcycles can also start in class of modified motorcycles. In this case they have to be registered in both classes separately and with another start number.

Riders briefing is obligatory.

Prize-giving will be held within 30 minutes after race.

Jury has a right for eventual changes of time schedule.

In case of re-riding of heat rider has a right for a preparation of his bike in time of 15 min for riders of the class "Modi" and 30 min. for riders of the class "special". Rider needn't to use this time.

12. Prize money

The first riders in each class will receive a cup and presents from race promoter.

13. Protests

All protests must be made in according to Disciplinary and Arbitration code of ACCR, and have to be accompanied by fee of 5000 CZK.

14. Fuel

Organizer will not deliver the fuel.

Nearest fuel station: Mnichovo Hradiště

Riders must have absorption mat under the bike that will prevent accidental oil or fuel leaks.

15. Insurance

By endorsing the application form for entry the FMN of the rider certified that the rider is insured in accordance with FIM regulations.

Riders must be insured according to ACCR Rules.

According to ACCR Sporting Code organizer is responsible to arrange insurance for liability of riders for damages occurred during sporting event. Payment for this insurance is a part of the starting fee.

Organizer is not responsible for any motorcycle damage in accident, fire and other cases.

16. Final regulations

Every rider is taking part in race at his own expenses.

JURY can make any amendments to Supplementary regulations only according to ACCR Sporting Code, Art. N 100.3.

Apart of the requirements of the FIM/UEM/ACCR Sporting Code, riders by participating renounce all rights of appeal against the organizer, his representative or agents by arbitration or before a tribunal or any other manner not foreseen by the FIM/UEM/ACCR Sporting Code for any damages for which they could be liable in consequence of all acts or missions on the part of organizer, his officials, representatives or agents in the applications or contributed to or arising out of their actions.
